


[Escaping the Devil's Bedroom](#)



Violence, Poverty, and Prostitution by Jody Raphael "Olivia left an alcoholic, violent home at age 16 in the hopes of becoming a dancer in one of Chicago's clubs on Rush Street, known in the 1970s for its strip joints. She'd already been drinking for over seven years to numb herself to the beatings her mother routinely received from her father, so it was an easy step to self-anesthesia via alcohol and drugs as her increasingly degrading stripper's life led her to prostitution and the streets, a life she lived for 19 years until she escaped the lifestyle via the Genesis House, eventually becoming a director of addiction services at a community counseling program for drug-dependent women"





[The Sacred Bath: An American Teen's Story of Modern Day Slavery by Theresa L. Flores](#)


Author Theresa Flores shares her story of trafficking and slavery while living in an upper-middle class suburb of Detroit Michigan. At fifteen years of age, she was drugged, raped and tortured for two long years. Kept in bondage, forced to pay back an impossible debt. All the while living at home, attempting to keep family safe and attending school during the day along side of her abusers. Only to be called into 'service', late each night, while her unknowing family slept. Involuntarily involved in a large underground criminal ring, Flores endured more as a child than most adults will ever face their entire lives.


[The War on Human Trafficking by Anthony M. DeStefano](#)

In *The War on Human Trafficking*, Anthony M. DeStefano covers a decade of reporting on the policy battles that have surrounded efforts to abolish such practices, helping readers to understand the forced labor of immigrants as a major global human rights story. DeStefano details the events leading up to the creation of the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000, the federal law that first addressed the phenomenon of trafficking in persons. He assesses the effectiveness of the 2000 law and its progeny, showing the difficulties encountered by federal prosecutors in building criminal cases against traffickers. The book also describes the tensions created as the Bush Administration tried to use the trafficking laws to attack prostitution and shows how the American response to these criminal activities was impacted by the events of September 11th and the War in Iraq.




[Not For Sale: The Return of the Global Slave Trade -- and How We Can Fight It by David Batstone](#)


[Redeeming Love by Francine Rivers](#)


Sold by Patricia McCormick

Sold is the account of thirteen-year-old Lakshmi, a Nepalese hill girl whose stepfather sells her to a rich city woman who calls herself "Auntie." Auntie soon shows her other side and brokers Lakshmi to an Indian brothel called "Happiness House," run by a cruel madam. Lakshmi is told that she must work in the brothel to repay her family's debt - a debt that seems to grow each day she stays in Happiness House. Told in a series of vignettes, Sold gives a vivid picture of child sex trafficking in the Indian subcontinent.







Nevertheless, Wilberforce finds the inspiration in newfound love to rejuvenate the fight with new ideas that would lead to a great victory for social justice.
