Preliminary question: Tell me briefly about your organization (what do you do in / with / for the community?)

1. What are the greatest assets and strengths you see here in this community? What gives you hope when you think about this community and its future?
2. What are your main concerns about life in this community? What do you see as the major social, economic, cultural or spiritual challenges here?
3. What kinds of changes have you seen in the community? Overall, are things getting better or worse?
4. Finish the sentence: "The most important thing for people to know about this community is..."
5. Finish the sentence: "This community will be stronger and better for everyone when ..."
6. Our church is considering ways to serve this community. Do you have any suggestions?
7. Can you recommend two other people or organizations that we should talk to, to help us learn more about this community?
8. From your vantage point, is there anything else I should know about this community?
